The Bharat Scouts & Guides, India will organize yet another National Jamboree 2007 as a great finale to commemorate the 100 years of Scouting. This second centenary special Jamboree will be held from 25th to 31st December 2007 at Burari, along Karnal Road, Delhi. The Jamboree site is about 1 hrs drive from Indira Gandhi International Airport.

Delhi is the third largest city in India and now the most preferred city in terms of investments, industrialization, Information Technology, Healthcare, Real Estate, etc. New Delhi, the National capital of India is famous for its culture, tradition and effervescent history. Delhi is the most preferred tourist destination of North India. Delhi's rich tradition, effervescent history, monuments, museums, galleries, Parks and Mughal Architecture are some of the special attractions that beckon tourists from all over the world. Date:- 25th to 31st Dec, 2007.

Participants are expected to arrive on 24th December (Monday) and depart on 1 January 2007 (Tuesday).

Venue:- Burari Sant Nirankari Ground, along Karnal /GT Road

Theme:- One World and One Promise.

Eligibility:- Scout aged between 14 ~ 17 and Rovers up to 20 years old.

Each patrol should consist of eight Scouts and one Adult Leader. Each National Scout Organization may form more than one Patrol.

Weather :- Average temperatures in December are around 10^oC ~ 18^oC.

Equipment:- Participants should bring personal camping equipment, including sleeping bag, personal cutlery, flashlight, swim suits, rain-wear, Tents will be provided.

Jamboree Fee:- (i) For SAARC countries fee is US \$ 50 per person.

(ii) Over sea participants US \$ 100 per person.


The cost covers food, program activities, camp souvenir, transportation to and from International Airport and the Jamboree site.
