

**THE OLAVE AWARD FOR
OUTSTANDING SERVICE TO THE COMMUNITY
2009 - 2011**



THE OLAVE AWARD must be:

- a spontaneous effort with no thought of recognition;
- the sustained effort or outstanding achievement of a group.

THE OLAVE AWARD will be made to:

- a group (six or Pack, Patrol or Company/Troop) of Brownies, Girl Guides/Girl Scouts or Rangers.

DEADLINE:

The deadline for applications is the end of September 2010.

PRESENTATION OF ENTRY

Application must be made by a Commissioner on behalf of the group and without its knowledge. It should be sent to the World Bureau by the National Organization.

Enter by completing the attached form, Appendix II, including details of how the project links to the Millennium Development Goals. As part of the project description, include the objectives, activities, outcomes and the impact within the community. Use one extra sheet of paper to describe the project, if necessary and attach it to Appendix II.

Supporting recommendations from responsible persons both within and outside the Movement must be sent with the entry. The recommendations should be no more than 500 words in length.

Please send up to ten photographs of the project.

Only ONE entry from each National Organization will be accepted.

THE OLAVE AWARD will be judged:

- by a panel of five judges, appointed by the World Board, to represent the WAGGGS Regions.

THE OLAVE AWARD will be in the form of:

- a badge to be presented to each unit member involved in winning the Award, which they will be entitled to wear during their membership of WAGGGS. A certificate presented to the winning group and a copy which will be presented to the National Organization at the next World Conference, to be retained in the Headquarters.
- a certificate of recognition will be awarded to each group entry for the Olave Award in tribute to the service rendered to the community by the group.

THE ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE WINNER will be made at the World Conference in July 2011.
